

Implementation and Intent Statement for Modern Foreign Languages.



Progress

The scheme we use is well planned and resourced, with differentiated resources to suit learners at different stages and of different abilities. The aim is that children will be well prepared for continuing to learn a foreign language as they progress on to Secondary School.

Children can self – assess, Teachers can assess as the children progress through the unit and at the end of each unit there are assessments that can be completed.



Content and Sequencing

We use Language Angels scheme of work and resources. This is because it ensures that we offer a broad, vibrant and ambitious foreign languages curriculum which will make learning exciting as it covers a range of topics and themes. Pupils will build on their previous knowledge and this will be revised, recalled and consolidated as part of lessons.

We follow a long term plan where MFL is taught alternate half terms. It has also been selected and adapted for mixed age year groups and coverage across Key Stage 2.

The four key language learning skills of listening, speaking, reading and writing will be taught alongside necessary grammar in an age-appropriate way.



Enrichment Activities

Children will learn to perform simple songs and rhymes and to play games in French.

We will have Foreign language assemblies to celebrate special national days such as Fête des Mères / Pères and Bastille Day.

Children will learn to respond to the register and / or simple classroom questions in French.

We will have cookery lessons inspired by, and using French recipes.

We will celebrate European day of languages (including parents / carers when possible.)



Cross-Curricular Links

Children will be encouraged to make links in their learning across the curriculum, such as finding France on a map, or knowing that there are other countries that speak French around the world within our Geography lessons.

As mentioned previously, children will learn about the importance of National days of celebration in France and the history that is celebrated, music that is performed, and also learn to prepare and enjoy food from that country and culture as well.

In Science we can explore the contributions of famous French Scientists such as Louis Pasteur, Marie Curie and discoveries like the hot air balloon.
