Our curriculum has been designed following careful analysis of the Public Health England Data Sets. Ensuring our curriculum is needs led and specific to the issues facing our children in school and beyond in the wider community. All lessons are delivered by a teacher with the support of a teaching assistant.

At points children are taught in discreet year groups to ensure they receive age appropriate content. Pre-teach opportunities used to support the emotional and social needs of children where necessary. Use of 'Ask it baskets' to facilitate tailored learning. Whole staff RSHE training delivered.
